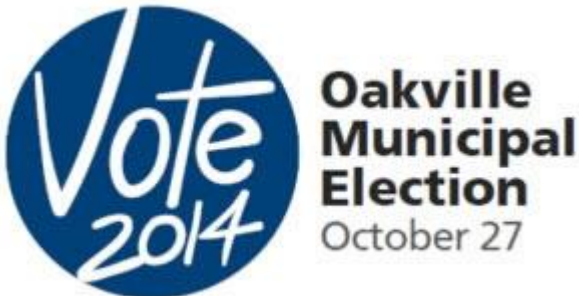

Meet the Ward 3 [Candidates Event](#)

Ward 3 residents associations will be hosting a Ward 3 all-candidate event on Wednesday, October 8th. This event is being held at Oakville Trafalgar High School, 1460 Devon Rd., with doors opening at 6:15 p.m. Residents will have time to meet with the candidates prior to the moderated Q and A event, which runs between 7:00 and 9:30 p.m.



The meeting will begin with questions posed to the five mayoral candidates, followed by the two candidates running for Ward 3 Town and Regional Councillor, and then the eight candidates who have put their names forward to serve as Ward 3 Town Councillor. Invitations have been extended to all candidates.

Oakville has a 13-member council with two Councillors from each of its six wards. Each ward has one Town Councillor who serves only on the Oakville Town Council and one Town and Regional Councillor who sits on the Oakville and Halton Region Councils. As Town and Regional Councillor Keith Bird is retiring, I am running as your Ward 3 representative on both the Oakville and Halton Region councils.

There are eight candidates who are running for the Ward 3 Town Councillor position that I have held for the past four years. As I have put my name forward for the Ward 3 Town and Regional Councillor position, there will definitely be one new face on Town Council! You will be selecting one of the following to replace me as your Town Councillor.

Voter information

You will need your voter card and proper identification to vote. If you are an eligible voter and have not received your voter card in the mail, please call 905-815-6015 or email elections@oakville.ca.

All advance voting locations are physically accessible and will have accessible voting equipment. On October 27, voting day, Town Hall will be fully accessible and will be open to all voters for accessible voting regardless of where you reside in the municipality.

Voter Qualifications - A qualified voter must be:

- A Canadian Citizen at least 18 years of age
- A resident of the Town of Oakville or the owner or tenant of land in the Town of Oakville, or the spouse of such owner or tenant
- Not prohibited by law from voting on Voting Day

What do I need to bring? Identification and Voter Information Notices are all you need!
